Time out for a serious note!

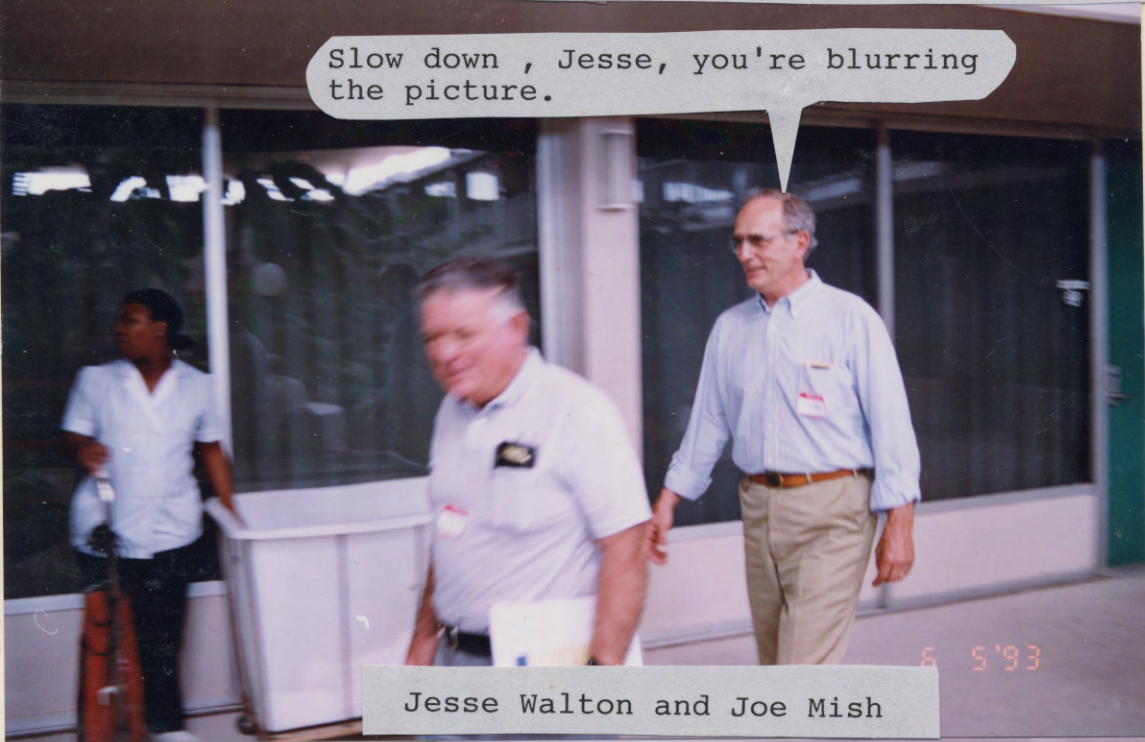
