Announced one at a time, with granting of subsequent cease-fires dependent on how ~~many~~ <sup>the</sup> enemy respects cease-fire at the time. This should be determined by consultation with the various nations concerned.

Should the enemy violate the first 24 hours of the Tet cease-fire, the remaining 24 hours should be ~~revoked~~.

The length of the Tet cease-fire would be subject to final determination after the first of the year, depending on the enemy's respect of the Christmas and New Years cease-fires.
