1. Sec. McNamara would like to bring along the General in charge of the barrier, General Starbird, to brief us while we are eating. He would then withdraw as we took up other items. The General is just back from Vietnam and has an interesting and important story to report on the changing attitudes of the Marine Commander and Westmoreland toward the barrier.
