MR. PRESIDENT:

I had occasion to ask Bill Bundy about Dean Acheson, while raising with him the generation of Viet Nam materials for Cabinet member speeches.

Bill reports:

-- He does not believe that Mr. Acheson harbors any ill-will over the "confrontation" on European policy, and he would be delighted to be called in again;

-- It is Bill's guess that Mr. Acheson believes we should not get out of Viet Nam; we should weather the political storms at home and only stop bombing if we receive appropriate recompense through the actions of the other side.
