

Saturday, February 17, 1968

Information from Saigon as of 1:15 pm

Tan Son Nhut received 20 rounds of Mortar fire. Vietnamese Air Force conducted strikes against the area where the mortar fire originated -- results are not known.

The Chapel area and three buildings were hit; one round hit just outside MACV headquarters. Several fires were reported on the flight line. Three persons have been reported wounded and three buses damaged. The Joint General Staff compound received two hits.

Approximately 4 miles east of Saigon, Tu Duc city was also reported under fire, with a water plant and an ARVN Infantry School being hit.

Nha Be, 5 miles south of Saigon, reported a tank farm was reported under attack. (presumably POL)
