MEMORANDUM:

SUBJECT : Possible New Offensive in Vietnam

1. Signs are accumulating that a new Communist offensive may be imminent.

2. Attacks appear most likely to come in the central highlands, possibly coordinated with other assaults against urban areas and/or allied military installations along the northern coast and in the DMZ area. In the III Corps area the disposition of enemy forces in the provinces surrounding Saigon remains relatively unchanged.

that attacks in Binh Duong, Bien Hoa, and Long Khanh provinces are planned for the very near future. These developments constitute something of a reversal of last week's trends when a number of enemy units were noted moving away from areas of tactical interest.

3. In general,

mortar, artillery, and rocket attacks would be featured in a new offensive. The Communists have strong forces within striking distance of a number of urban areas, however, and a new thrust into selected towns and cities cannot be ruled out.
