1. Signs are accumulating that a new Communist offensive may be imminent. |

2. | attacks appear most likely to come in the central high-lands, possibly coordinated with other assaults against urban areas and/or allied military installations along the northern coast and in the DMZ area. In the III Corps area the disposition of enemy forces in the provinces surrounding Saigon remains relatively unchanged. |

attacks in Binh Duong, Bien Hoa, and Long Khanh provinces are planned for the very near future. These developments constitute something of a reversal of last week's trends when a number of enemy units were noted moving away from areas of tactical interest. that

3. In general, | mortar, artillery, and rocket attacks would be featured in a new offensive. The Communists have strong forces within striking distance of a number of urban areas, however, and a new thrust into selected towns and cities cannot be ruled out.
