(LAPES) platforms on payloaders. Payloader backs up to C-130. VS, men of the 109th QM Co load lumber on a drop platform. Load is tied down with straps. VS, men slide load of lumber from pay loaders into C-130. VS, men tie supplies and equipment on drop platforms. C-130 flies by dropping supplies in LAPES. (Several good takes). In one drop the load bursts into flames.

Summary: Int, two soldiers fold a cargo parachute. They tie it in sections and pack it into a cover. (Dark) Int, soldiers fold and pack pilot chute and attach it to the main chute. VS, soldier carries packed chute into a CONEX container. VS, soldiers use forklift to pick up and carry CONEXs to storage area. VS, soldiers prepare 55 gal drums for airdrop. They use an A-22 canvas container. VS, soldier pushes skid load on rollers to parachute rigging area. VS, soldiers attach chutes to loaded skids. VS, forklift carries parachute rigged loads to a tractor trailer. VS, tractor trailer drives on highway to airfield. MS, sign: "109TH AIR DELIVERY CO"
