March 26th the golden dragons and the drednorts pursued the remnants of the
infiltration units and by early afternoon were again engaged in the enemy.
After artillery, air and infantry assaults routed the VC with practiced pro-
fessionalism all the enemy who weren't dead on the ground and 108 were -
were rapidly going somewhere else. Operation Thietthong continued another
12 days til April 7th. But Charlie had had enough of 2nd brigade there
were no more significant contacts.
