13. Supply and Civil Affairs: UNCL

a. Supply:

(1) The CH-47 A has proven to be the most effective and efficient vehicle available for providing logistical support to forward units. Its inherent ability to respond quickly to changing tactical situations, rapid delivery speed, and relatively greater allowable AGL, has made it an invaluable asset in situations prohibiting the use of over land resupply techniques.

(2) When tactical situations permitted, replacement and evacuation of vehicles and materiel was accomplished, by the CH-47 A helicopter, CH-54 flying cranes, and river rafts.

(3) Treatment of casualties, evacuation and hospitalization of WIA's and KIA's to Cu Chi and Long Binh hospital was accomplished rapidly and efficiently by helicopters.

(4) A total of 1,974 CH-47 A sorties were used on operation ~~SARATOGA~~ to move more than 168,000 tons of class I, II, IV, V TLL, mail and personnel from Cu Chi Base Camp to forward areas.

b. Civil Affairs/Psyops

(1) Medcaps: A total of 206 Medcaps (Medical Civic Action Program) were conducted throughout the Brigade TAOI. A total of 27,472 patients were treated.
