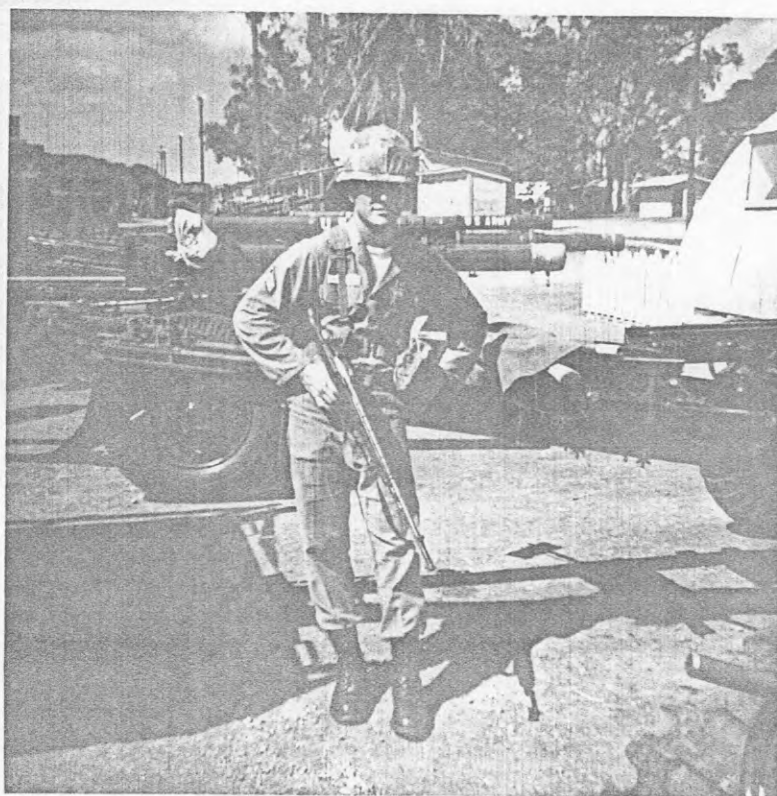


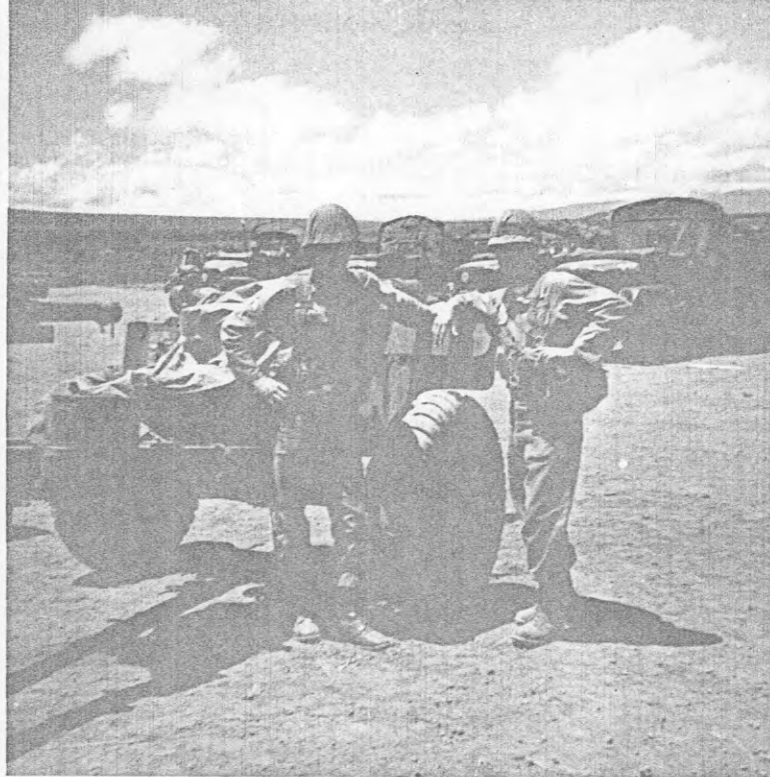

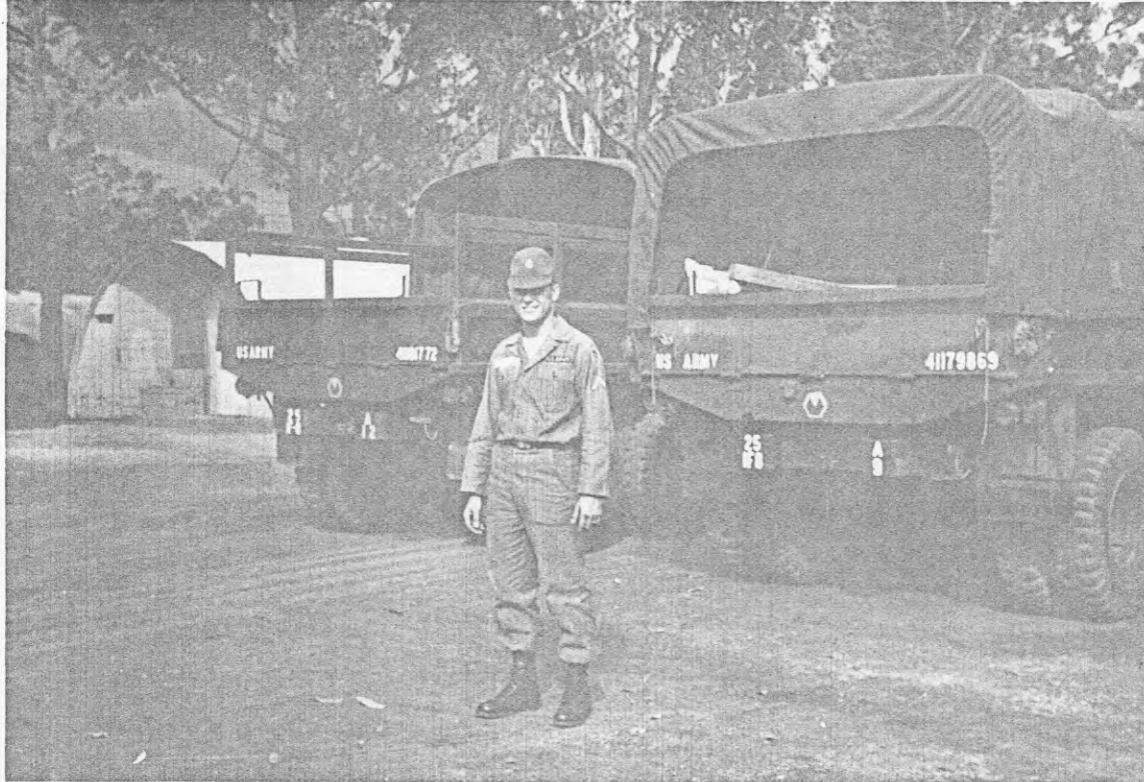
March 1965 when I was Battery commander driver

Hawaii POHAKULOA Training area.



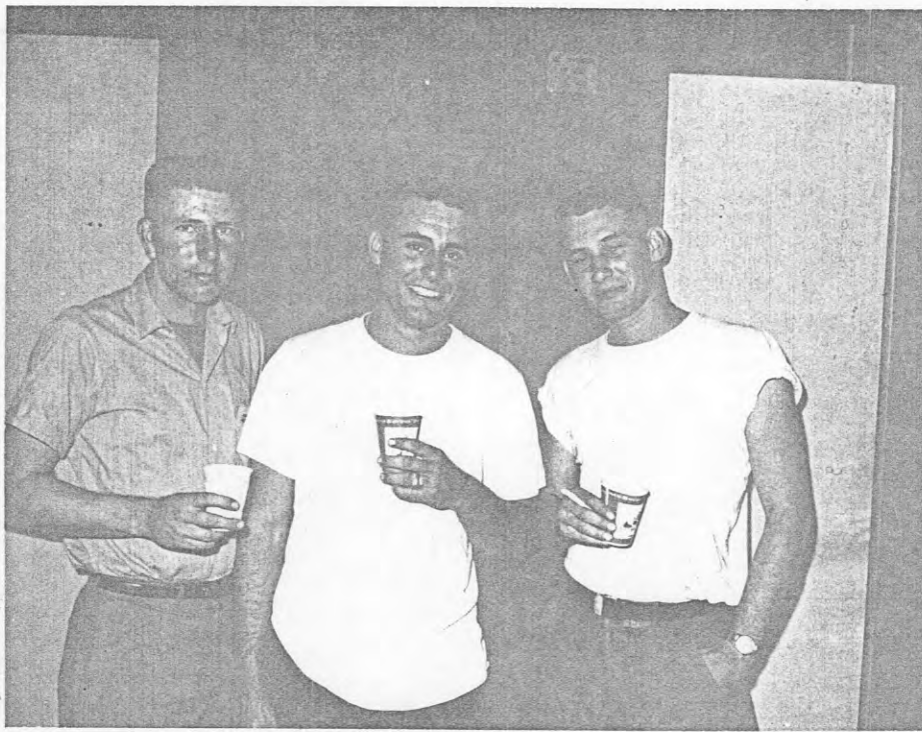

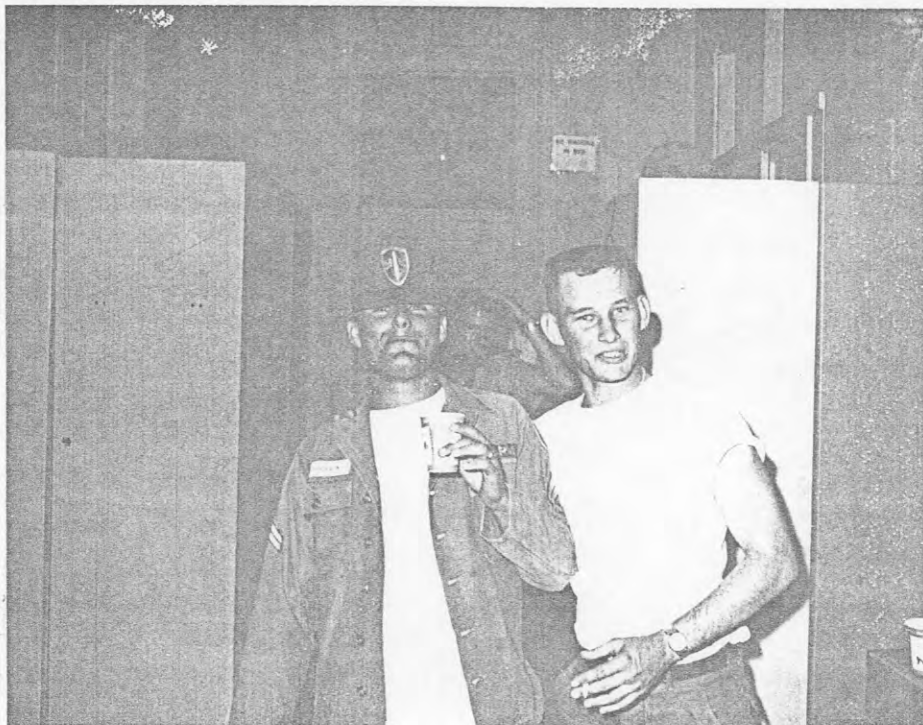

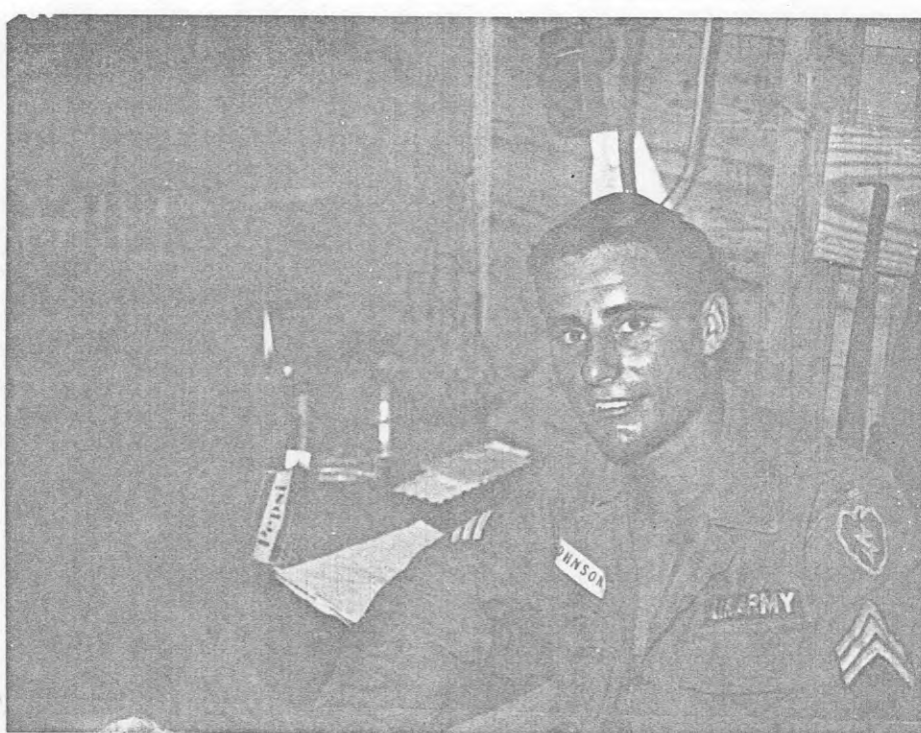

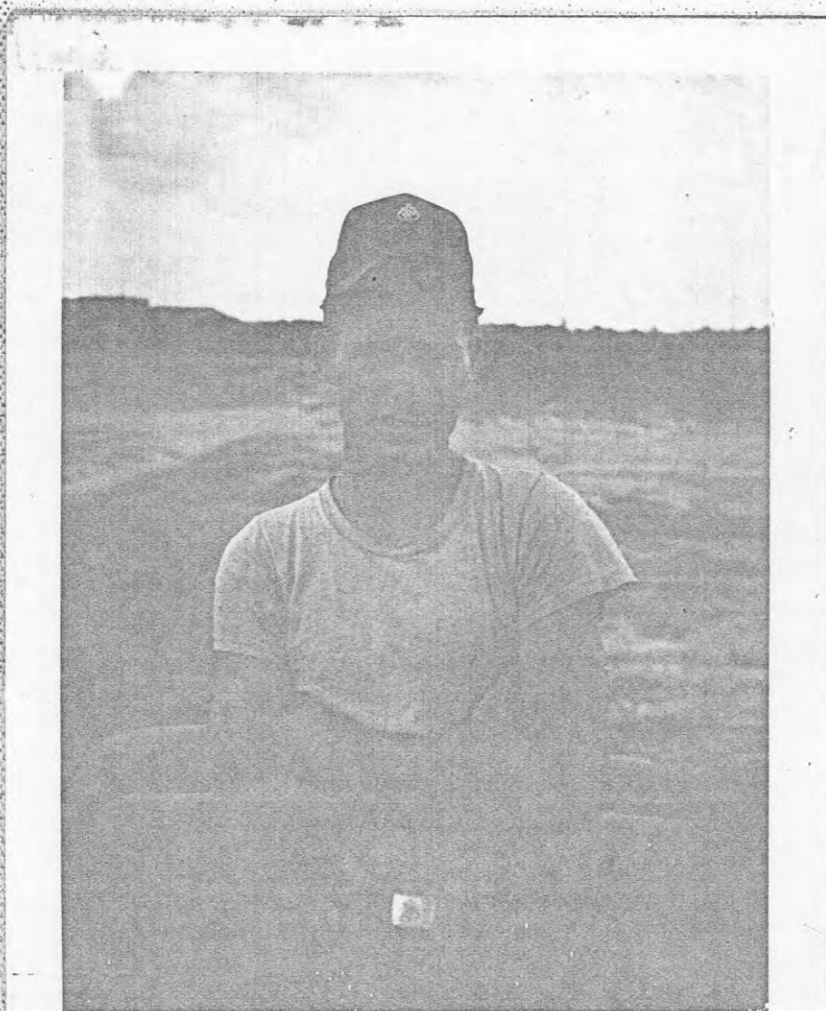
