

Flt 1: BLACKHAWKS, 187th AHC, 10 slicks, 1 spare, 1 maintenance.

Flt 2: BLACK WIDOWS, 188th AHC, 10 slicks, 1 spare, 1 maintenance.

Gunships: RAT PACK 2 LFT, SPIDERS 2 LFT, RAT PACK control.

1. (X) SITUATION:

a. Enemy: As briefed.

b. Friendly: 3-22d Infantry Bn conducts airmobile assault to conduct cordon and search in AO.

c. Attachments and detachments: None.

2. (X) MISSION: 269th Combat Aviation Battalion conducts airmobile assault lifting 3-22d Infantry Bn in three lifts into one LZ. Support operation with gunship preparation of LZ.

3. (X) EXECUTION:

a. Concept of operation: Two assault helicopter companies lift 3-22d Inf Bn from PZ TAY NINH in three lifts, separate touchdown into same LZ after artillery and gunship preparation.

b. Annex A: Operation Overlay.

c. Annex B: Sequence of Events.

d. Fire support:

(1) Air: Combat Sky Spots may be performed early in AM.

(2) Artillery: From TAY NINH 0650-0710.

e. Gunships:

(1) Escort all lift ships.

(2) Mark LZ 1 on each lift.

(3) Preparation of LZ 1 0710-0715.

(4) Cover AO and engage targets as directed by C & C.

f. Pathfinders: Provide control by radio at PZ TAY NINH on lead company frequency.

g. Smoke NORTHEAST of LZ 1 on each run to include departure route.

h. Coordinating instructions:

(1) Altitude: 2000 ft.

1 0500

Smoke ship take off GC. for weather check and drop off pathfinders.

2 0600

C&C aircraft departs CC for TN.

3 0620

BLACK WIDOWS depart for TN.

4 0635

BLACKHAWKS line up to SOUTH PZ TAY NINH. Trail. Shut-down.

5 0640

BLACKWIDOWS arrive PZ TAY NINH. Line up. Trail EAST side of BLACKHAWKS to the SOUTH. Shut down.

6 0645

C&C aircraft takeoff TN.

7 0650 - 0710

Arty prep of LZ-1 (XT090568).

8 0659

Lift aircraft start engine.

9 0700

RATPACK report to C&C vicinity RP-1.

10 0701

Lift aircraft load troops, 6 pax per aircraft from 3-22 FALCON.

11 0703

Lift aircraft takeoff TN to the SOUTH, route BLACK, heavy right formation, 2000', 20 second separation between companies.

12 0710 - 0715

Gunships prep of LZ-1. RATPACK mark.

13 0712

Lift aircraft RP-1.

14 0715

Lift aircraft land LZ-1 (XT090568). Heavy right formation to the NORTHWEST, BLACKWIDOWS land in same LZ, 20 second after BLACKHAWKS, same formation. Takeoff right sharp turn low level over trees to open area, then climb direct to PZ TAY NINH.

15 0721

Lift aircraft land PZ TAY NINH. Load 6 pax per aircraft.

16 0722

Lift aircraft takeoff TN route RED, 2000' heavy right, 20 second separation between companies.

17 0727

Lift aircraft RP-2. Route RED.

18 0729

Lift aircraft land LZ-1 same as previous lift off shallow right turn.

3 0620 BLACK WIDOWS depart for TN.
4 0635 BLACKHAWKS line up to SOUTH PZ TAY NINH. Trail. Shut-down.
5 0640 BLACKWIDOWS arrive PZ TAY NINH. Line up, Trail EAST side of BLACKHAWKS to the SOUTH. Shut down.
6 0645 C&C aircraft takeoff TN.
7 0650 - 0710 Arty prep of LZ-1 (XT090568).
8 0659 Lift aircraft start engine.
9 0700 RATPACK report to C&C vicinity RP-1.
10 0701 Lift aircraft load troops, 6 pax per aircraft from 3-22 FALCON.
11 0703 Lift aircraft takeoff TN to the SOUTH, route BLACK, heavy right formation, 2000', 20 second separation between companies.
12 0710 - 0715 Gunships prep of LZ-1. RATPACK mark.
13 0712 Lift aircraft RP-1.
14 0715 Lift aircraft land LZ-1 (XT090568). Heavy right formation to the NORTHWEST, BLACKWIDOWS land in same LZ, 20 second after BLACKHAWKS, same formation. Take-off right sharp turn low level over trees to open area, then climb direct to PZ TAY NINH.
15 0721 Lift aircraft land PZ TAY NINH. Load 6 pax per aircraft.
16 0722 Lift aircraft takeoff TN route RED, 2000' heavy right, 20 second separation between companies.
17 0727 Lift aircraft BP-2. Route RED.
18 0729 Lift aircraft land LZ-1 same as previous lift. Take-off shallow right turn, low level over trees to open area, then climb direct to PZ TAY NINH.
19 0735 Lift aircraft land PZ TAY NINH. Load 6 or 7 per aircraft.
20 0736 Lift aircraft takeoff PZ TAY NINH, route GREEN, heavy right formation, 20 second separation.

1.(C)Bn Command Frequencies: UHF 258.2 (Alt 233.9); FM 69.70 (Alt 66.2).

2.(C)Unit Frequencies:

a. 187th: FM 63.85; UHF 233.9.

b. 188th: FM 69.05; UHF 360.4.

3.(C)Pathfinders: CAVALIER TAY NINH 63.85 and *69.05.

4.(C)Med Evac: TAY NINH WEST - TANGO ACTION 56.10.

5.(C)Recovery: PIPESMOKE CONTROL (Contact C & C).

6.(C)Artillery: Through C & C. FOCUS 53 (FM 69.30).

Air: Through C & C.*

7.(C)Ground units: FALCON 2-12th FM 36.0.

8.(C)*Code: REROUTE CHARLIE, transmitted three times by the C & C aircraft, indicates that a change to the alternate frequency is necessary. At this time all elements will change frequencies to the above assigned alternates.

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1. (X) SITUATION:

a. Enemy: As briefed.

b. Friendly: 3-22d Infantry Bn conducts airmobile assault to conduct cordon and search in AO.

c. Attachments and detachments: None.

2. (X) MISSION: 269th Combat Aviation Battalion conducts airmobile assault lifting 3-22d Infantry Bn in three lifts into one LZ. Support operation with gunship preparation of LZ.

f. Pathfinders: Provide control by radio at PZ TAY NINH on lead company frequency.

g. Smoke NORTHEAST of LZ 1 on each run to include departure route.

h. Coordinating instructions:

(1) Altitude: 2000 ft.

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- (2) Airspeed: 60 knots forming, 80 knots enroute.
- (3) Formations: Trail in PZ, heavy right enroute and LZ 1.
- (4) Aircraft load: 6 or 7 pax per acft.
- (5) Rules of Engagement: SOP.
- (6) Door gun suppression: Outside door guns on 1st lift.
- (7) LZ marked with smoke by RAT PACK.
- (8) Downed aircraft procedures:

- (a) Contact C & C.

- (b) Recovery ship on standby at TAY NINH WEST 0700-0830.

- (c) Security force: Last two aircraft of flight. LFT provide cover.

- (d) Best base for emergency landing: TAY NINH WEST.

- (9) Reports to C & C:

- (a) Out of PZ and LZ by each flight.

- (b) RP by each flight.

- (c) Any fire received.

- (10) Weather decision by AMC 010530 Sep 67. 30 minute increments.

4. (U) ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS:

- a. Refueling: None scheduled. TAY NINH WEST available.

- b. Rearming: TAY NINH WEST.

- c. Medevac: US personnel to TAY NINH WEST.

- d. Spare aircraft: One per company, under company control.

- e. Maintenance aircraft: One per company, under company control.

5. (U) COMMAND AND SIGNAL.

- a. Signal: Annex C (Signal).

- b. Command:

- (1) AMTF Commander: LTC Harold.

- (2) Air Mission Commander: LTC Merryman.
