1. (u) SITUATION:

a. Enemy: As briefed.

b. Friendly: 2-12th Infantry conducts search and destroy operations in the SOUTHEAST sector of the MICHELIN Rubber Plantation.

c. Attachments and Detachments: None.

2. (u) MISSION: The 269th Combat Aviation Battalion conducts an airmobile assault lifting 2-12th Inf into five LZ in the SOUTHEAST portion of the MICHELIN Rubber Plantation. The 269th will also provide gunship cover for the airmobile assault as well as smoke in the LZ to the best tactical advantage.

3. (u) Execution:

a. Concept of Operation: Two AHC will lift 2-12th Infantry from PZ DAU TIENG (XT192472) into five initial LZ, vicinity coordinates XT570501, XT562497, XT567493, XT560488, and XT575480. The first insertion will consist of Flt 1 and Flt 2 landing with 30 second separation between flights into LZ-1. Simultaneous landings of both flights will insert ground troops into LZ-2 and LZ-3 utilizing 18 A/C. The third lift will consist of 19 aircraft, 10 ships into LZ-4, and 9 into LZ-5. No air strikes or artillery preparations are planned. However, artillery and air will be on call through the C&C aircraft. Four other LZ have been selected, but will be used as the tactical situation develops.
