**Korean Dr
Kills 305 V**
SAIGON (AP)—Two divisions of South Koreans about 240 miles northeast of Saigon have killed 305 enemy troops in an operation begun July 9, Korean spokesmen reported Monday.
Korean casualties in the continuing action were described as light.
Called Kil Tong Hong after a man famous in Korean history for his sense of justice, the operation is being conducted by South Korea's Tiger and White Horse Divs. It is a search and destroy mission 22 miles inland from the coastal town of Tuy Hoa.
In addition to the enemy reported killed, the spokesmen said, 24 prisoners had been taken, and 12 defectors had turned themselves in. A large haul of enemy arms also was reported, including 147 individual and 60 crew served weapons plus other equipment. Weapons seized some
