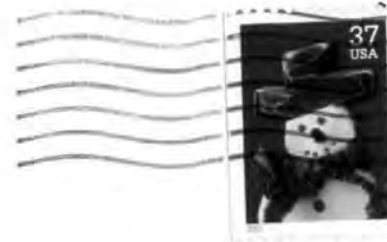

Dick:

I originally went to Nam with Co.D. 1st Bn (Abn) 501st Inf, 101st Abn Div Dec 1967. I was W.I.A Mar 12, 1968 both legs and chest outside Hue. After being released from the hospital I was sent back the rear for 60 days light duty and rehab at Bien Hoa. There I volunteered as D/G. I was sent to the 1st Aviation Brigade with duty with the 188th at LZ Sally right back where I started from. Typical Army run- a- round. That was May 1968. Then when it changed to the 101st Aviation Bn I was C. Co until Sep 1968 when I transferred to D.Co. The reason I transferred no K.P. or perimeter guard duty. I extended 6 months to go back to the 501st and finish my 11B tour. I derosed Dec 1968 from D. Co. Returned Jan 1969 to the 501st, derosed July 1969. Extended two more times but for the 173d and 1st Cav. All as a GRUNT. Had all the air I wanted.

I thought I had more with C.Co, but the rest of what I have is with D.Co. Anyway hope it is helpful.


PLT. 1st I think, and SP/5 Toule was one of my Crew Chiefs.
