KEEPING THE PEACE -Fueled by centuries old religious and cultural animosities, warring factions of the former Yugoslavia waged an especially bitter war until a peace agreement was signed in Dayton, Ohio on November 21, 1995. To monitor and enforce compliance with the military aspects of the agreement, a multi-national Peace Implementation Force (IFOR) deployed with a one-year mandate authorized by United Nations Security Council Resolution 1031. IFOR operates under clear NATO Rules of Engagement, which provides for robust use of force if necessary.
