That picture is of a special team getting ready to be inserted into Song Be, to tap a communication wire that we discovered two days before. On that very mission the tall man in the rear wearing glasses. SGT Dave Parker was killed as well as some of the Cambodian soldiers and the team had to split up as they were being chased by the NVA. The team was on an E & E course and the remainder of the team members were extracted. We found Dave Parkers body three days later in the same location, the enemy had not found him. We did not find the Cambodia soldiers though.
