AIRCRAFT OF HONOR



1LT(R) Green and an OH6 in Vietnam

1LT (R) Gary Green was assigned to A Troop, 2nd Squadron, 17th Cavalry Regiment, Republic of Vietnam. During his time in country 1LT Green amassed over 1600 combat missions and was shot down seven times. His awards and decorations include the Distinguished Service Cross, the Silver Star with 2 Oak Leaf Clusters, the Distinguished Flying Cross with 3 Oak Leaf Clusters, the Bronze Star with V Device, the Air Medal with V Device, the Army Commendation medal with V Device, and the Purple Heart with two Oak Leaf Clusters. 1LT Green is a Distinguished Member of the 17th Cavalry Regiment.

The OH6 on display today was one of the seven shot down with 1LT Green at the controls. The aircraft was later recovered, sold to a Florida police department, then restored to its original condition as it appears today.
