Enclosed are some photos of LZ Sally from 1966 and 1996. About all that was really recognizable at Sally was the railroad bed and the remains of the airstrip. I went out there in October 1996 with Larry Moak while the rest of the 101st Return-to-Vietnam tour did Hue City. Larry had been a helicopter pilot at Sally with C Company, 101st Aviation Battalion from October '68 to October '69.

I was the Executive Officer of the 1st Bn/321st Field Artillery from June to December 1969. Formerly I had been the DivArty S2. LTC Edward Basanez was the commander. He later became the 101st DivArty Commander and the Division Chief of Staff at Fort Campbell before he retired. I retired in 1986 and have been working for a Defense Contractor, Logicon Inc, at Fort Leavenworth since 1987. We run computer-assisted, command post training exercises for Army corps and divisions. We have done the 101st several times at Fort Campbell. The next time will be this June.

My friend and classmate Dick Schonberger, who is now the Vice President of the 101st Association, organized the trip in 1996, and he is now working for the travel agency, The Global Spectrum, to set up reunion-type tours for veterans going back to Vietnam. I hope to make another trip with him in the not-too-distant future.
