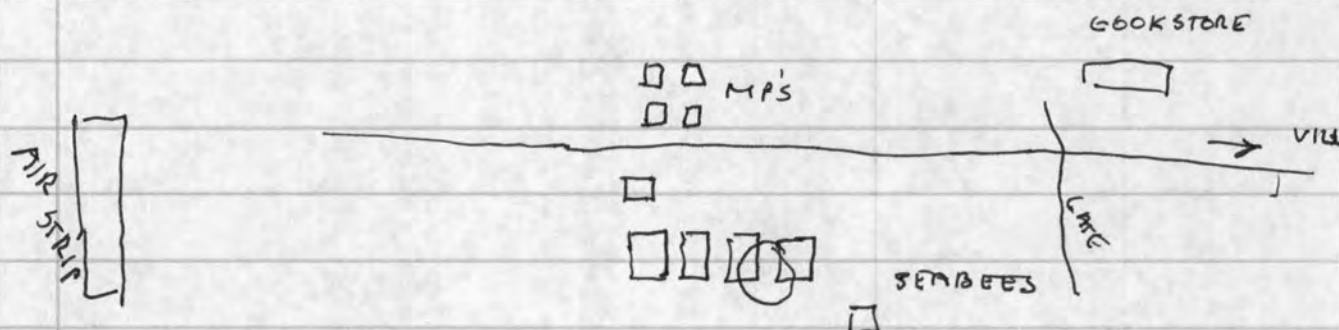
DICK,
