LZ Sally

YD 639-275

Aka FSB Sally. Built on the site of Van Xa hamlet appx 12 km NW Hue, 11 km ESE Camp Evans, 2 km W of Thon Van Xa village, 3 km SSE An Lo Bridge, near PK-17, and appx 1 km W QL-1. Airfield may have been built by the French but in the American war, the 1st Cav Div apparently were the first to establish a position here and its construction as a permanent facility apparently began in earnest, 28Feb68. According to Lt Gen John Cushman, Sally was named after wife of 1st Cav Co Cmdr.¹ By Oct68, permanent bldgs were replacing tents and the base had become 2d Bde HQ, 101st Abn 68-70, 1/321st Arty, C Bty, 2/11th Arty (155mm), I Corps, 101st Abn Div 2d Bde HQ until Mar70. In Oct96, LTC Thomas Morgan visited the former site of LZ Sally and found a large cement plant operating there; photo and story in the Mar98 issue of ARMY magazine.² Also listed as YD 649-284. Thua Thien Prov, I Corps.
