After 1945, the runway was built by the Michelin Society for its three Million Aircraft. The hospital was built since the origin of the Plantation in 1927. It has 300 beds. MICHELIN MICHELIN

The Plantation belongs to the SOCIETY OF PLANTATIONS AND PNEUMATICS OF VIETNAM which is a part of the INTERNATIONAL GROUP OF MICHELIN. This group also owns the THUAN LOI (PHONG HONG) Plantation and a pneumatic tire factory in SAIGON.

The activity of the Plantation was suspended since the center was destroyed by aerial bombing during the Battle of DAU TIENG in June, 1965.

When both the DAU TIENG and THUAN LOI Plantations were in normal activity, the Society employed about 5000 workers and the annual production was 10,000 metric tons of dry rubber. 5000 workers was 10,000 metric tons of dry rubber.

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The Plantation belongs to the Michelin Society of Plantations and Pneumatics of Vietnam which is part of the International Group of Michelin. This society also owns the Thuan Loi (Phong Hong) Plantation and a Pneumatic fabrication factory in Saigon.

The activity of the Plantation in Thuan Loi has been suspended because the center was destroyed by aerial bombing during the Battle of Dong Xoi in June, 1965.
