Back then the 188th Assault Helicopter Company was flying UH-1H and UH-1C model Bell helicopters. It was the beginning of a proud Aviation heritage and tradition, which today is carried on by the "BLACK WIDOWS" of Alpha Company, 9th Battalion, 101st Aviation Regiment.

During 5 years of combat operations, that included all four Corps Areas of Operation and beaucoup trips across the fence into Cambodia, Laos and North Vietnam, the "BLACK WIDOWS" earned the respect of the grunts we supported and were well known as an elite and dependable company...no matter what the mission entailed. During that period the company sustained casualties of...40 KIA and over 100 WIA. In July of 1968 the 188th, which was instrumental in the 101st's transition from parachutes to helicopters, was redesignated as Charlie Company, 101st Aviation Battalion, making the 101st Airmobile.

Today, as you ready yourselves for deployment to Afghanistan, our nation stands united in support of your efforts to rid the world of these terrorist fanatics. I would like to say on behalf of the "BLACK WIDOWS" who have served before you, "That we're behind you 100%! Stand tall and proud my BLACK WIDOW brothers and sisters and if by chance you are able to kick some serious ass along the way...by all means make it happen".
