Post-Reform Import Tax Rate Schedule

Attached is the complete Import Tax Rate Schedule effected by the GVN Economic Reform Program of Nov. 15, 1971.

Because the basic exchange rates will fluctuate over time, it was decided to depart from the previous practice of showing a final effective import rate. The user can determine the effective import rate for any commodity code by applying the Customs tariff, as well as perequation tax and subsidy, if applicable, to the basic exchange rate for the appropriate category of financing (i.e. GVN or AID). In this format we have designated goods as "CIP", "P.L. 480 Title I", or "GVN, CIP", if joint-financed. All commodities not identified as being in one of these three categories, can be considered GVN-financed or eligible for third-country financing.

The following additional qualifications apply to this listing:

1. The VN \$200 piaster per dollar tax on finished textiles was not actually a part of the Reform Program, but was enacted by decree of Nov. 19. Moreover VN \$200/U.S. \$1 is actually the initial tax. The formula establishing the tax (Tax rate = $700 - 1.25 R$, where R is the basic exchange rate) assures that it will decline as the basic rate rises.
2. The subsidy on fertilizer products, shown as VN \$157/\$1, is expected to decline to a smaller figure after Jan. 1, 1972.
3. The subsidy on pesticides is not yet settled. The figure of VN \$125/\$1 represents the best current guess.
4. A perequation tax of VN \$75/\$1 applies to P.D. 31 (CIP) imports, but is not shown here inasmuch as the tax applies to source rather than the commodity designation.

Post-Reform Effective Import Rates

Attached is a set of tables covering the import rate structure following the GVN Economic Reform Program of Nov. 15, 1971. The new effective rates have in most cases, including the Summary Table D, been compared with the Pre-Reform import rates to enable a measurement of the impact of the devaluation on import costs.

Users are cautioned to note that the import categories shown on these tables are rather broad, often encompassing many individual commodities with separate import rates. The import rates appearing in these tables are our best estimates of the averages of the rates within each category. Moreover, since the new exchange rates will fluctuate over time, these should be considered as initial Post-Reform rates only. In most cases - i.e. except where perequation taxes and/or subsidies apply - effective rates can be kept up to date by applying to the initial effective rate the percentage changes in the basic exchange rate as they occur.

As explained in the footnotes, the rates shown in Table A (GVN Import Rate) do not reflect the numerous tax exemptions in effect before the Reform Program. The degree of devaluation on GVN imports calculated on this basis was 9%. With the effect of tax exemptions included, the devaluation on GVN imports amounted to 16%. In Table D, which summarizes all imports, the exemptions were included (as were exemptions on certain CIP imports). With all Pre-Reform exemptions included, the amount of the devaluation on all imports, using 1972 weights, is calculated at 19%.
