HA NOI

The Capital Of Ascending Dragon

Ha Noi, the cradle of Vietnamese civilization, is rich with historical relics, ancient temples and pagodas. Ha Noi is regarded by many visitors as the most charming and beautiful city in Southeast Asia.

HOAN KIEM LAKE (Lake of the Restored Sword)

Lying in the center of Ha Noi, Hoan Kiem Lake is the focal point of various activities, because many residents come here to practice their early morning Tai Chi Kuan exercises. In the tale, the soon to be King Le Loi was taking a boat trip on the lake when he was offered a sacred sword to be used to defeat the Ming army in the 15th century. After the battle, 10 years a tortoise surfaced from the lake and the sword was returned.



HO CHI MINH'S MAUSOLEUM

It is here that the nation's leader was laid to rest, and to this day his embalmed body remains on display for visitors to pay homage.



ONE PILLAR PAGODA

Built of wood on a stone pillar 1.25 meters in diameter, One Pillar Pagoda is designed to resemble a lotus blossom, symbol of purity, rising out of a sea of sorrow.

TEMPLE OF LITERATURE

Built in 1070 by Emperor Ly Thanh Tong who dedicated it to Confucius in order to honor scholars and men of literary accomplishment.

Vietnam's first university was established here in 1076, dedicated to the sons of Mandarins.

Traditional music and dance are performed inside.

THE OLD QUARTER

This bustling shopping area has been in existence for centuries. In the past, each street produced and traded in a certain group of commodities from which their names were derived.



SAIGON - HO CHI MINH CITY

A Pearl of the Far East

The largest city in Vietnam, cosmopolitan Ho Chi Minh City (formerly Saigon) built 300 years ago, is graced with broad avenues, French colonial architecture, street side cafes, shopping areas and grand public buildings.

NOTRE DAME CATHEDRAL

Built between 1877 and 1883, it is one of the city's major landmarks. It is built in a neo-Romanesque form and represents the major seat of Catholic religion in southern Vietnam. On Sunday evenings, the whole of the square in front of the Cathedral fills, as the congregation gathers for the service.

JADE PAGODA

Built in 1892, the pagoda is dedicated to a pantheon of mythical Chinese - Vietnamese divinities, in a mixture of Taoism and Buddhism.

BEN THANH MARKET

This is the largest of the city's major markets, close to town and offers a wide range of local and imported products. The most interesting time to visit is early in the morning when fresh produce is brought in from the surrounding provinces.

GIAC LAM PAGODA

Built in 1744, this is the oldest Pagoda in Ho Chi Minh City. Situated close to Chinatown, the pagoda evokes a feeling of "another world" with its pungent incense, funeral tablets and carved inscriptions.

THIEN HAU PAGODA

Built in 1863 by the Chinese-Vietnamese of Saigon, the pagoda is dedicated to the Goddess of the Sea and decorated with intricate ceramic effigies.

RE-UNIFICATION MALL

The modern-style former palace of President Thieu and his predecessors is today set aside as a museum and venue for official receptions. Inside the building, visitors can see the private rooms of the President, the "War Room" from where the South Vietnamese forces were controlled, and most impressively, the room where all the Liberation forces finally met for the national reunification in 1975.



CHOLON (China town)

Ho Chi Minh City is home to about one million Chinese. The area of Cho Lon is particularly colorful and busy. In particular, the market of Cho Lon has a range of goods and vibrancy that is greater than other areas.

CU CHI TUNNELS

One and half an hour drive from Ho Chi Minh City, the Cu Chi tunnels are one of the few remaining monuments to the Vietnam War. Beneath the ground lie 200km of tunnels, dug by hand and inhabited by the Liberation Forces. At its peak prior to the Tet offensive, the tunnel complex was the base to almost 10,000 troops, and to this day remains one of the most powerful examples of how the war was fought.

TAY NINH

Cao Dai Holy Shrine

Tay Ninh is home to the Cao Dai religion. Exclusive to Vietnam, this mysterious sect draws its origins from Christianity, Buddhism, Taoism, Hinduism, and Islam. Included amongst the Gods are William Shakespeare and Victor Hugo.



MY THO

The Mekong Delta

Known as "The Rural Heart of Vietnam" where you can see brilliant green rice paddies stretching towards the horizon, the Delta area is also abundant with fruit orchards and traditional fish farms.

My Tho's visit includes floating markets, boat excursions to fruit orchards, Dong Tam snake farm and Vinh Trang Pagoda. You also have the opportunity to taste "Elephant Ear Fish" specialties, and return to Ho Chi Minh City on the same day

PHU QUOC ISLAND

Luxury Escape To The Tropical Paradise

This island is the largest island in Viet Nam with a surface area of 56,800 hectares equivalent to the surface of Singapore. The name of this island signifies "rich island".

Phu Quoc Island has a high tourist potential since visitors can benefit from the sea, rivers, forests, mountain in a same location.

Khem Beach is the most beautiful beaches here for its white sand, which resembles powdered chalk, and stone rocks. Coming here, tourist can take sea bathing, fishing, and enjoy local specialties.



VUNG TAU

Fresh air & sun warm sea beach

Known as Cape St. Jacques under French rule, Vung Tau is the closest beach resort to Ho Chi Minh City (125 km) and has retained its popularity with the Saigon people. Every weekend, this seaside town overflows, as families and courting couples alike come to enjoy the fresh sea breeze and boardwalk atmosphere.



DA LAT

The Dreaming City in the Highlands

Graced with pine trees, lakes, valleys and romantic flower gardens, Da Lat attracts honeymooners to enjoy the crisp mountain air and a variety of activities. Quaint chalets dot the serene lakes where horse-drawn buggies are the preferred mode of transportation.

Da Lat's visit includes the famous market, the Da Lat flower gardens, Da Lat cathedral, Prenn and Datanla Falls, Valley of Love, and Buddhist pagodas. Trekking into the forests can be arranged upon special request. Accommodation is in traditional houses built on stilts.

Half way to Da Lat from Ho Chi Minh City is the Damb'ri Waterfall (22km off the road). The foggy scenic-33 meter high fall through the tropical trees is worth the climb up and down.



NHA TRANG

Wonderful White Sandy Beaches With Clear & Blue Water

One of the most attractive coastline cities, Nha Trang is graced by beaches with powdery white sand. Offshore islands provide interesting excursions.

Nha Trang's visit includes the Oceanographic Institute, Hon Chong Rocks, Tri Nguyen Outdoor Aquarium, Po Nagar Cham Towers and boat excursions to Hon Yen or Monkey Island. You can enjoy the deep blue coral reef offshore by scuba diving or snorkeling.



DA NANG

The Harbor City In Central Vietnam

The city of Da Nang is situated halfway between the northern and southern parts of the country. Ancient treasures surround the port city, a former bastion of the Champa Kingdom. Many of the temples in the area are dedicated to the God Shiva, the creator and protector of the Champa and the Champa Dynasties.



CHAM MUSEUM

Built in 1915 and formerly called *Henry Parmentier* Museum, this building houses more than 200 stone and terra-cotta sculptures, typical of the Cham culture, created between the 7th and 15th centuries.



MARBLE MOUNTAINS

Five large hills, known as Mountains of the Five Elements, are filled with mysterious caves with altars dedicated to divinities. During the Vietnam war, these caves were used by local guerrillas as field hospitals and shelters.



HOI AN - A World Heritage

Since the 17th century, the town of the Hoi An has been an important commercial port. Today, this enchanting town is a living museum dedicated to the past. This complex of historical relics features hundreds of ancient houses, each one representing unique architecture. Situated 30 km south of Da Nang, the rooftops of Hoi An retain a magical old world oriental feeling and are understandably a favorite subject matter for Vietnamese artists.

MY SON SANCTUARY

A World Heritage

My Son lies in the valley southwest of Da Nang. Once the capital of the Kingdom of Champa (5th-12th century), the valley was graced with 68 magnificent kalans and temples. The site was the most important intellectual and religious center of the Cham people and most of the temples were dedicated to Cham Kings associated with divinities.

It takes over one hour by coach to reach My Son from Da Nang and a 4 km ride on the back of motorcycle taxi to the main site.



HAU - A World Heritage

Ancient Capital Of The Nguyen Dynasty

Hue was considered the most splendid royal capital of Vietnam from the 1700s to the 1940s. Once the center of culture, education and religion, Hue is the site of many important temples, monuments, mausoleums and pagodas. The district consists of a complex of Citadels and Palaces, with inner courtyards and passages, covering an area of more than 500 ha on the northern border of the Huong (Perfume) river. This was once the political center of the Nguyen Dynasty and the residence of royal families.

In 1994, Hue was awarded the status of World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

Hue's visit includes Royal Tombs, Ancient Citadel, and Thien Mu pagoda and boat excursions on the Huong River. Royal Music and Dance performances can be arranged upon special request.

THIEN MU PAGODA

Located on Ha Khe Hill on the banks of the Huong river, 4 km from the Royal Citadel and revered as the most important Buddhist shrine in Hue, the Thien Mu pagoda dates back to 1601. Since then, the pagoda has been rebuilt many times. For centuries, the seven-tiered Phuoc Duyen Tower of the pagoda has been the symbol of Hue.



KHAI DINH MAUSOLEUM

It took 10 years (1920 to 1930) to build this magnificent structure. Set on a hill 12 km from Hue, the mausoleum features a combination of western and eastern architecture. Stone soldiers, elephants and horses stand on guard in the courtyards. One of the particular interests is the workmanship used to join broken pieces of porcelain and glass into decorative patterns on walls and ceilings of the building.



HA TAY

THE PERFUME PAGODA

The Perfume Pagoda is a Buddhist temple set in mountain caves, to which thousands of Vietnamese make annual pilgrimages. The temple is reached by boat, plus a four or five hour climb.

NINH BINH

HOA LU: Vietnam's first capital

Hoa Lu was Vietnam's first capital, and lies in a region similar to Ha Long Bay, with limestone crags rising steeply from the valley floor. Hoa Lu's visit includes a sampan trip to Tam Coc Caves, Bich Dong Pagodas, and the two beautiful ancient temples of Dinh Tien Hoang and Le Dai Hanh.



HOA BINH

Ethnic Tribe Villages

Located 110km southwest of Ha Noi, the region is known for its beautiful tapestry and is home to many ethnic groups, especially the Muong, Dao and Thai. Adventurous travelers can stay at a local village to learn about the cultures and traditions of these fascinating people.

Trekking tours can be organized upon special request.

SA PA

Beautiful Highlands

The mystical town of Sa Pa lies near the foot of Fansipan - Vietnam's highest peak and closed to the Chinese border. In addition to the refreshing cool air, imposing mountain peaks and drifting valley mist, there is another charming attraction to this market town. On Saturday afternoon, people from Lao Cai's hill tribes dressed in native costume flock to Sa Pa. At night, men court groups of women by inviting them to exchange love songs (sometimes by cassette players!). The lover's dialogue outside of music is often simple and short. Some lack a common language, as the region is rife with distinctly different dialects.

Sapa is recommended only in the Spring and early Autumn months due to the cold climate and poor visibility at other times of year.

DIEN BIEN PHU

1954 Battle Field

Located 417km northwest of Ha Noi, in a highland region inhabited largely by the Thai minority, Dien Bien Phu was the site of the famous Vietnamese victory against the French army in 1954. In addition to the beautiful mountain scenery, there is the opportunity to visit the Thai and other minority tribes, and to see the valley where the famous battle took place.



HA LONG BAY

A World Heritage

Ha Long Bay, situated in the Gulf of Tonkin, is dotted with more than 3,000 rock islands that have some of the most exquisite beaches in the world. The bay is graced with intriguing limestone rock sculptures and numerous grottoes that lend a magical presence to the place. This seaside resort is uniquely picturesque with sails of junks and sampans gliding on the bay.

According to the legend, the islands were the petrified tail of a giant dragon, which was sent from the Heaven to save innocent fishermen from marauding invaders. Said to be where the "dragon descended into the sea" Ha Long Bay is one of the most spectacular and romantic of all Vietnam's physical wonders. Ha Long Bay has been awarded the Status of World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Population: 76,324,753 (23 July 1999)

Ethnic groups: 53 groups: Chinese, Chams, Khmer, Lde, M'ong...

Religion: Buddhism, Catholicism, Protestantism, Confucianism, Taoism, Islam, Hinduism, Caodaism. The Vietnam's universal religion is the practice of ancestral worship, born of the belief that the soul lives on after death and protects its descendants.

Language: Vietnamese is a tonal language comprised six tones. Accents and some words are distinct in the three regions: North, South and the Central.

Currency:

Dong. Exchange rate: US\$ around 14,500 dong (May 2001)

US dollars are generally accepted at any bank or exchange counter.

Credit cards (Visa, American Express, JCB, and Master Cards...) and traveler cheques are accepted in V.T.U.T. Co. and major cities.

Vietnam code: 84; Ha Noi: 4; Ho Chi Minh City: 8; Da Nang: 511; Hue: 54

Vinaphone code: 913; Mobiphone code: 903 followed by six digits.

VISA TO VIETNAM

Visas are usually granted at Vietnamese Embassies and Consulates abroad.

Travelers should apply for a visa through V.T.U.T. providing the following passport details: full names, date and place of birth, occupation, passport number, date of issue and expiry, nationality, date and point of entry to Vietnam, place to collect visas.

V.T.U.T. will submit these particulars to Vietnam's Immigration Department. Approval for the visit may take 5 - 7 days. Once approval has been received, the Immigration Department will send a fax or telex approval to the Vietnamese Embassy or Consulate where the visitor wishes to obtain the visa.

Upon notification of this approval from the Immigration Department, V.T.U.T. will send a fax copy of the approval to relevant agent to inform them.

When notified, please submit the clients' passports, 4 photographs and the fax copy of the visa approval to the Embassy or Consulate to collect the visa. The visa stamp fee is to be paid at the time.

VISA APPLICATION FORM

It is a requirement that all visitors complete the form titled "Vietnam Visa Application form". This document is not required prior to authorization of the visa but must be completed for submission to the Immigration desk upon arrival (along with visa issuance at overseas embassies, and an entry/exit cards).

In Ho Chi Minh City: TÂN SƠN NHẤT Airport, 5 km from downtown. International airport tax: US\$12.00/pax.

In Da Nang: ĐÀ NẴNG Airport, 5 km from downtown. International airport tax: US\$12.00/pax.

In Ha Noi: NỘI BÀI Airport, 30km from town. International airport tax: US\$12.00/pax.

for domestic flights, airport tax is 25.000VND

Meter taxis are available in major cities with the average cost of 12.000VND (US\$ 0.80) for the first 2 km of the ride.
