

INSTRUCTIONS

1970 - 1971 Elections to Board of Directors

Attached is your BALLOT, listing the names of forty-five (45) members named by the Nominating Committee as candidates for the Board of Directors.

NOTE:

1. It is preferred that you vote for one person in each line (total 15) so board distribution will be representative of areas in Southeast Asia, of those MIA and POW, and - to the extent possible - of the various services and geographic areas in the United States. You may, however, vote for any fifteen (15) you choose.
2. Read attached Candidates' Affiliation on each nominee.

DIRECTIONS FOR VOTING:

1. Vote for NO MORE than fifteen (15) people. Ballots with more than 15 candidates marked will be automatically declared INVALID.
2. Circle in INK name for whom you vote.
3. Or, write in name of candidate of your choice, if not already listed. But all such candidates must have indicated to you their willingness to serve.
4. Affix your legal signature IN INK in the space provided bottom of ballot.
5. Return ballot in the envelope provided.
