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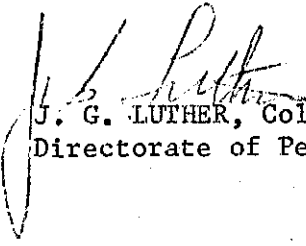
Dear Air Force Next of Kin

As you remember the prisoner of war film which you viewed at the recent briefing for the families of missing in action and captured Air Force personnel did not have a sound track. However, there is a tape recording of a portion of the comments that were made by some of the prisoners.

Rather than reproduce the tape recording and disseminate it to those next of kin who attended the briefing, we are attaching a fact sheet pertaining to the film which not only contains the prisoners' comments found on the tape recording but also some other information regarding the various scenes shown therein. We also ask that you bear in mind that the film was a propaganda effort on the part of the enemy, and that information given by the prisoners may not necessarily be correct.
