
Re: Army Photos

I have recently discovered some old photographs of my time with "E" Company in 1967-68. These photos are of some of the troops in training in Pleiku and other areas. Many of these photos show us practicing emergency evacuations, hanging from ropes from supporting Huey helicopters, and others repelling off a practice tower. There are others showing teams in full camouflage about to be airlifted to jungle patrols and others just showing down time.
