I did not know him well, and my memory is not the best but as I recall his name was Bill or William Squire or Squires. He was a Sergeant E-5 and Team Leader within 3rd Platoon. He was killed in September or October of 1969 while on an operation out of Phan Thiet. His team was set up in an ambush on a trail when the NVA came up behind the team. In the ensuing fire-fight Squires was killed and Les Stenke was WIA. The only other team member I remember the name of was Tony Rivera who was on rear security. I hope this information helps.

I won't be able to attend the reunion this year, but am already saving money for next year at Ft Lewis, WA. If you are able to attend the reunion this year, tell anyone who happens to remember me that I'm still alive.

By chance do you have an address on Mike Price? That is one person who I would like to contact. I don't know if you knew him, but the Mike Price I was with did not match the man pictured in Ericson and Rotundo's book.

Tell your wife that she did a good job on the poem, one would have thought that she had been there. But then I guess after all these years a lot of our wives can say that they have been there.
