Daniel,

As to #1 I think that those who have donated photos would be more than happy
to have you release them for publication in a book honoring the Rangers in
Vietnam. I think that if you put a notice to the effect that you plan to do
just that if you are not notified to the contrary would suffice to cover us
legally. Also place a notice in the next newsletter and give 10 days for any
response telling you not to release the photos. If you do not receive any
notices then I would say that you have covered yourself and the Association
legally.

Regarding #2 I agree that, perhaps, a donation to the Association would be in
order, one that would be agreed to in writing prior to the release of any
information or photos. I don't believe that an author of this caliber would
object to that, but is only my opinion.
