<< Thank you all for the feedback. There are several worthwhile observations
 that have come out of this as follows:

(1) We should get some kind of monetary compensation out of it.

Due to our non-profit status we cannot blatantly ask for payment. So, what I suggest is that we ask for a donation out of the royalties.

Knowing what I do about writing a book, it is a fact that no one is going to get rich publishing anything except maybe Clancy! So, what I suggest is that we simply get a commitment from him for a donation from the proceeds in whatever amount he sees fit. I see it as a tradeout. If we only get \$50 and we get our history preserved for posterity then we've done that much. Especially if he does it right!

(2) It has been suggested that a board vote be taken.

I see this as very proper procedure for anything we do with association property, and our historical archives are definitely that!

It was also suggested that we provide some kind of blanket notice in case anyone objects. This is a good thought but I don't think it is necessary because:

(1) We have already released them once to a college ROTC archive so the precedent has already been set, and

(2) The photos have, in fact, been published for all the world to see in a historical photo archive on the website, so what's different about them being put in a history book?
