Dear Mr. Pope:

This is in reply to your request concerning records of Company E, 20th Infantry and Company C, 75th Infantry.

We searched the records of the Records of the United States Forces in Southeast Asia, 1950-1975 (Record Group 472) and located roughly 2,200 pages on Company C and roughly 225 pages on Company E. Enclosed are copies of the indexes to these records. If there are records in which you have an interest, we would be happy to provide a price quote. Our current fees are \$0.25 per page for electrostatic (paper) copies and we have a minimum charge of \$6.00 for all mail orders. Allow at least 12 weeks for delivery. Please do not send a check or money order until you have received a price quote.

We will be pleased to make the records available to you or your representative in our research room. The Suitland Reference Branch (NNRR) is located at the Washington National Records Center, 4205 Suitland Road, Suitland, MD, about one mile from the District of Columbia line (Southern Avenue). Research room hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. Monday through Friday, except legal holidays.

Beginning in November 1993, the National Archives will begin to move more than 800,000 cubic feet of records from several facilities to its new building, Archives II, in College Park, MD and to the main Archives building in Washington, DC. The move will continue through 1996, and during that time, various record groups will be closed for research and reference activities, including requests for information and reproductions. If you are planning a research trip to Washington within the next three years, please verify with each reference branch that the records you want to see will be available.

Dear Mr. Pope:

This is in reply to your letter concerning U.S. Army unit records for Vietnam.

We have custody of these records. However, there are gaps in these records. We have what the Army retained. We may have types of documents for one unit (for example, after action reports) and not for another. Our indexes list the records available for each unit.

Enclosed is an annotated copy of one page of the index for Company C, 75th Infantry. It indicates there are two boxes of daily journals, the first box containing journals from August 17 - October 31 1970, and the second, journals from November 1 1970 - October 18, 1971.

The records of the Records of the United States Forces in Southeast Asia, 1950-1975 (Record Group 472) closed for the move on February 16th, and should reopen in roughly 2 months at Archives II in College Park, MD.
