Curtis,

The film is on its way to you and should be there by Friday, 8/29/02. The film is in a canister with a short note to you inside the canister.

I have received permission from Morton Roth and Randall Logan to have you post their stories. I expect all to give their approval and I will let you know as they get back to me.

Randall Logan will be in contact with you. He wants to set up a collection and will add some photos to go with another version of the "FSB Jaeger" story. We have agreed that his story "FSB Jaeger", as shown on the 15th Engineer web site, will be posted as part of the 15th Engineer Battalion, Combat collection.

If I am not making much sense let me try again – there will be two versions of Randall's story. One is the 15th web site posting and the other one Randall will send you along with some photos. The Vietnam Archive will end up posting the "FSB Jaeger" story twice (two different versions) into two different collections – I hope this is not a problem.

Curtis, you indicated that you would be able to process the film by mid to late September. That is great! I really expected to wait much longer. Will the digitized version be available for viewing or downloading from the Archive's web site?

Also, what is the timeframe for posting the "stories?" Not trying to push anything – just attempting to get an idea of when.

Lastly, there are many photos and a few historical documents (mostly 9th Infantry Division) on the 15th web site, some of which may be helpful to the Archive. What is the best way of sorting the junk from the good items? I can make a list of what I think would be useful or you can cruise through the web site and pull what you feel is useful. Let me know what I need to do.
