SUGGESTIONS FOR VETERANS

APPOINT A POW/MIA CHAIRMAN to coordinate POW/MIA activities for the chapter or post; add his/her name to the League's mailing list to ensure membership updates. The following public awareness opportunities should be considered:

POW/MIA Adoption Program: In addition to the standard guidelines for adoption, veterans may: Re-name the chapter, post or unit for the missing man and reserve an empty chair in his honor at all functions.

Speakers: Obtain a knowledgeable POW/MIA speaker for district meetings, state conventions and national events. If a speaker is unavailable, arrange a viewing of "SEEKING ANSWERS."

Booths at Meetings: Set up a table or booth at district, state or national meetings with POW/MIA information and "SEEKING ANSWERS."

Community Parades: Carry a POW/MIA flag and/or construct a banner; materials and suggestions are available from the League office.

AND

- Ask for proof of POWs from those who make unsubstantiated claims and, if provided, turn it over to responsible government authorities.
- Counter misinformation with facts!

REMEMBER: Americans still missing in Indochina need the strong, unified voice of our nation's veterans in support of the President's priority and the POW/MIA families.
