## Vietnam reveals more data on MIAs

■ **HANOI, Vietnam** — A U.S. senator said Thursday that Hanoi had handed over documents containing crucial information on American servicemen missing in the Vietnam War, an issue that has bedeviled U.S.-Vietnamese relations for two decades. "They have produced in fact more documents than we have requested," said John Kerry, the Massachusetts Democrat who heads the Senate committee investigating Americans missing in the Vietnam War. "There was very interesting information. They had shootdowns, dates of deaths, places of burial, and this is the critical information we are looking for," he said. Mr. Kerry and Bob Smith, R-N.H., arrived in Hanoi on Thursday for a two-day visit.
