FOR DJAKARTA

1. While still an open question whether Indos may move to break relations, concur we should be prepared for that eventuality. We see undesirable aspects, however, to approaching Japanese at this time re possibility represent us should severence relations occur. Such a move to saddle Japanese with role they would probably find difficult and unwelcome could cause undue apprehension and, with possibility of leak, exacerbate situation. Would appreciate Embassy's views on alternative arrangements which might be made if for some reason Japanese should prove undesirable or unwilling candidate.

2. More immediate need, in Department's view, is to assess whether situation is likely deteriorate erratically, essentially as result PKI action, or whether recent demonstrations against you and in Medan should be viewed as parts of concerted plan foreshadowing new and as yet unstated
