One shipload of 2,221 refugees arrived Saturday. Next ship now scheduled for 30 September. Vietnamese soldiers departed for Saigon Thursday. Tents now being erected with coolie labor directed by MAAG representatives. Slow process.

ATTENTION: F. C. Nyland

Procure 4,950 lineal meters of planks 0^m20x0.025 and 1000 lineal meters of wood 0.05x0.08 to be used for flooring of 12 hospital tents 5x15 meters in size.

One bulldozer and one grader with operators or two bulldozers needed immediately to prepare additional area opposite side road from present camp. Suggest Hackett return with jeep and pick up truck be sent with equipment.

ATTENTION: D. Weiner

DDT team needed immediately repeat immediately to combat insect breeding caused by unsanitary conditions resulting from overcrowding.

Send Crysol, Lysol or comparable disinfectant for pit privy maintenance.

Send immediately 200 large covered garbage receptacles.

Send 30 pumps complete with accessories and spare parts.

All of the above requests cancel and supersede all previous requests for all materiel.
