SAIGON

Following the conversation I had on Saturday Sept. 9, 54 with Dr. Nguyen van Kieu, President of the Vietnamese Red Cross and in agreement with him, I beg to inform you that as from this date, the Medical Service for Refugees in the Reception Centers installed in the Saigon-Cholon Prefecture will work until further notice as follows:

1/ PhuTho Camp - The Medical Service will be ensured on every Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday afternoons as from 4.30 P.M by the Vietnamese Red Cross. The duty tour and medical service on those days other than the 3 above mentioned, as well as the medical service on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday mornings will continue to be ensured by your medical service.

The American ladies who have so far lent their benevolent aid to the Medical Service of PhuTho Camp will continue to assist with the work as in the past.

2/ Other Reception Centers - The Medical Service of all the Reception Centers will be ensured by your service until the Vietnamese Red Cross is in a position to give their assistance.

3/ Cha Ca Camp (Bishop Adran Camp) The Medical Service of this new camp, now under construction, will be ensured by the Vietnamese Red Cross.

4) Patients' evacuation - The patients who will have to be hospitalized will be evacuated to GoVap Hospital as before.
