A tremendous discrepancy exists in the estimate submitted and accepted by our Mr. Burgess and the as-built price included in Mr. Adler's report. Further expenditure shall be required to improve these wells. An investigation should be made by the Controller's Office to determine through probable existence of running or accumulative cost accounts the exact expenditure of items.

For example: Well construction had been running about \$IC 14 - 17000 in areas away from the larger centers of population. This fee includes diversion funds to personnel of Public Works, contractors, etc., and is generally unavoidable because Public Works acts as our sub-contractor or representative in lieu of personnel we have been unable to get because of various administrative difficulties.

Even \$IC 14-17000 was well above Mr. Burgess' figure of 8 - 10,000. Further the costs of pit privies should include only cost of concrete slabs. It is recognized that due to emergency this may include the cost of "slit" trenches and the pit privies built at a later date.

The sanitation training may be a term erroneously applied to the "policy" of the camps. This seems high when based upon the actual amount of work done in a pattern of incontinuity.

In summation: There is no need for an alarm. The procedure follows the basic one long established in our programs. Recognizing an old need an inadequate number of personnel throughout all projects has been able to do a small part of the work required. At the present time much of the ground already covered will have to be redug and it is hoped the repetition will aid in an improved second answer.

What kind of Sanitation Training is being given? 225,698.93 \$IC for such training in one month seems like a lot of money.

Same questions apply to "HYgiene Education in Villages." (This is the normal health education project.)

Is there an American technician investigating these programs that are costing so much? (Emil Kotcher)
