Vietminh Activity - Ben-Co, An-Dung and Long Binh Refugee  
Villages - Bien-Hoa Province

FIELD REPORT NO. FS - 346

An assistant priest (brother) living in the village of Ben-Co has reported Vietminh activity in the form of speeches at the subject villages within the past three weeks.

These three villages are located in a cluster just off the east bank of the Dong-Nai River six (6) kilometers S.S.E. from Bien-Hoa.

By road they are 17 kilometers from Bien-Hoa.

By direct line they are 20 kilometers north of the recently burned villages in the Phuoc Ly area.

The villages are located in an extremely isolated area vulnerable to easy attack by land or water.

Survey questionnaires have been submitted for these villages.
