2. Command elements of 1-27th Inf and Co A/1-27th Inf will participate in a welcoming ceremony for an Australian Army contingent on Tuesday, 3 Oct 1972 at 1700 hrs. Ceremony will commence upon arrival of contingent at Hickam AFB. Command Elements of the 25th Inf Div and 1st Bde, 25th Inf Div may participate in this ceremony.
3. Commander, 1-27th Inf, Company Commander, A/1-27th Inf, 25th Div Band, Color Detachment, and Kolchak VI will participate and will be formed in accordance with inclosures 1 & 2. Uniform will be: TW's, garrison cap, low quarters.
4. 1-27th Inf, Company and Staff Requirements:
 - A. Combat Support Company is designated as color company and will provide a color detachment of five personnel. Personnel will report to CSM Kahanu for instructions. (Color detachment will include Australian National Colors).
 - B. Company A will provide a baggage handling detail of five personnel.
 - C. HHC will provide one 2½ ton vehicle for transportation of baggage.
 - D. S4, 1-27th Inf will coordinate bus and sedan transportation requirements. Vehicles will depart Quad D at 1530 hrs, 3 Oct 72.
 - E. S3, 1-27th Inf will direct operations at Hickam AFB and brief participants.



SEQUENCE OF EVENTS

1. Acft arrives at DV1 Ramp (Base Operations Bldg - Hanger Ave/F Street, Hickam AFB.)(Agricultural inspection will follow before deplaning).
2. Australian troops disembark acft. (Band will play Australian traditional music).
3. Commanding General, Bde CO, Battalion CO, CO Co A, and Kolchak VI greet contingent leader.
4. Australian Forces will form facing Base Operations Bldg, Commanding Officer A/1-27th will form with guidon, color detachment, and Kolchak VI opposite Australian forces and facing acft.
5. Australian forces will come to present arms. CO, A/1-27th will order "PRESENT ARMS" for ceremonial unit. (Band will play Australian National Anthem followed by United States National Anthem).
6. CO, A/1-27th Inf will order "ORDER, ARMS". Australian troops will come to order arms.
7. Commanding General, 25th Inf Div may welcome Australian contingent. (Remarks are optional).
8. Australian troops will receive leis and greetings (Band will play Hawaiian music at this time). (Baggage detail will unload baggage and immediately depart for customs areas).
9. Australian troops will board buses and proceed to United States Customs Briefing Area - Main Terminal, Hickam AFB.
10. After clearing US Customs, Australian contingent will proceed through Hickam AFB Terminal, board buses and depart for Schofield Barracks.
