THE OBJECTIVE OF THIS BATTALION FREE PLAY EXERCISE WAS COMPANY "A" PASSES COMPANY "C". ALPHA COMPANY WAS THE ATTACK ELEMENT AGAINST A HILL HELD BY CHARLIE COMPANY. THE ASSAULT STARTED AT</p>

ON THE 18th OF OCTOBER, 1972, THE COMPOSITE PLATOON OF AUSTRALIANS, FROM THE 8th AND 9th BATTALIONS, ROYAL AUSTRALIAN REGIMENT, PARTICIPATED WITH THEIR HOST UNIT ALPHA COMPANY, 1-27th INF, 25th INFANTRY DIVISION, IN A FIELD TRAINING EXERCISE AT KUHUKU TRAINING AREA ON ~~SH~~ OAHU ISLAND, HAWAII. THE OBJECTIVE OF THIS BATTALION FREE PLAY EXERCISE WAS COMPANY "A" ~~VS~~ COMPANY "C". ALPHA COMPANY WAS THE ^{ATTACK ELEMENT} AGGRESSOR, AGAINST A HILL TOP HELD BY CHARLIE COMPANY. THE ASSAULT STARTED AT A DISTANCE OF 3000 METERS FROM THE OBJECTIVE. AMONG THE INDIVIDUAL WEAPONS DISPLAYED WERE FLAME THROWERS, GRENADES (INCLUDING INCENDIARY, SMOKE AND THERMITE), DET CORD, MINES, PHU GAS AND A FIRE POWER DEMONSTRATION OF INDIVIDUAL WEAPONS COMPRISING A U.S. INFANTRY SQUAD.

CREW SERVED WEAPONS INCLUDED THE M-60, 30 CALIBER MACHINE GUN DEMONSTRATED DURING THE U.S. INFANTRY SQUAD FIRE POWER EXERCISE, ~~SH~~ AND THE 90MM AND 106MM RECOLESS RIFLES. support weapons included the Vulcan, Chopper, Huey, Cobra gun ships, and even helicopters and HO20 Huey. The Vulcan is mainly an anti-aircraft weapon firing 20mm cannon rounds operating on the mini gun principle, however this weapon can be engaged in ground troops support. The Chopper is a guided missile designed to down low flying ^{hostile} aircraft. The Gamma Boat vehicle was displayed to the Australians as new equipment designed to replace our 3/4 ton truck because of it's better mobility ^{over rough terrain}. The helicopters were brought in for the ~~aus~~ ^{aus} to inspect and ask questions about the helicopter capabilities and mission of the new even helicopters.
