SATURDAY THE 4th THE AUSTRALIANS WERE DRIVEN AROUND THE NORTHERN SECTOR OF HAWAII COUNTY, HAWAII, TAKING IN THE SCENIC DESERT COUNTRY OF THE WESTERN COAST, THE PARKER RANCH, SUGAR CANE FIELDS IN THE CENTRAL AND EASTERN COAST. DECIDING WHERE TO GO AND WHAT TO DO. LATER SHOTS DEPICT THE MEN CROSSING A STREET TO WATCH A LOCAL SATURDAY FOOTBALL GAME, DURING THE GAME A COUPLE OF MEN ATE CORN ON THE COB. FOOTBALL</p> <p>THE WEEK OF THE 6th THRU THE 10th., THE AUSTRALIAN PLATOON DEPARTED POHANULOA TRAINING AREA, HAWAII FOR ADVENTURE TRAINING ON MAUI COUNTY. ON THIS ISLAND THEY WERE TRUCKED TO THE TOP OF HALEAKALA VOLCANO, WHERE THE ADVENTURE TRAINING STARTED. THE AUSTRALIANS WALKED ALONG "SLIDING SANDS TRAIL" TO PALIKU THE FIRST DAY. THE SECOND DAY THEY WALKED IN THE RAIN TO "SEVEN SECREED POOLS". AT THE SAME TIME A CERTIFICATE WAS AWARDED TO THOSE WHO ACCOMPLISHED THE PIQ TRAINING. SEVERAL OTHER PERSONAL AND UNIT AWARDS WERE HANDED OUT. PANY AT (KMC). THE PARTY WAS IN THE FORM OF A BAR-B-Q. OTHER SHOTS SHOW THE EXTERIOR OF KMC AND MAUNA ULU VOLCANO MOUNT WHICH WAS ERUPTING AT THE TIME THESE MEN WERE AT KMC, VOLCANO NATIONAL PARK, HAWAII. AFTER THE MEN ARRIVED BACK TO SCHOFIELD BARRACK, HONOLULU COUNTY SHOTS OF THE MEN WERE GOTTEN IN WALKIE AND ALONG THE BEACH.

THE OPENING SHOT FOR THE FILM WAS FILMED AT SCHOFIELD BARRACK OF CPL ROACH'S SQUAD BEING INSPECTED FOR DIRTY RIFLES. THIS FILM WILL BE USED IN CONNECTION WITH WHAT LT. HORTON SHOT IN AUSTRALIAN THERE END SHOT WAS A CLOSE UP OF A AUSTRALIAN PLATOON WEAPON AND THE SHOT WENT OUT OF FOCUS. OUR SEQUENCE STARTED OUT OF FOCUS AND CAME INTO FOCUS OF THE SAME FORMATION IN HAWAII WITH THE MAN HOLDING A M-16 Rifle.

FILMED HERE WERE SOME OF THE WAITING WIVIES WAVING TO THEIR HUSBANDS AS THE DEPLANED AND HEADED FOR CUSTOMS.
