### S U M M A R Y

Save The Children Fund is a United Kingdom and its Commonwealth organization to save the needy children of the World. It presently operates in 27 countries and is about 50 years old. The Fund only enters a country at the request of that nation. All work comes from donations received from the English people and its commonwealth of nations.

The site at Qui Nhon was selected after touring the country, and finding Qui Nhon to have a high amounts of war victim and refugees. In the 20th day of Feb. 1967 the convalescent rest center was opened, to house between 40 and 50 children.

Most of the children are victims of the VC or suffer from malnutrition. When there are better the children are returned to their parents. While at rest center if the children are of age they attend school at the center. Currently the children range in age from several months to 14 years.
