SUMMARY

Security for Binh Trung Province, in which the South Vietnam capital of Saigon is located, is the job of the 199th Infantry. Security of the roads and water ways from the Viet Cong is one problem for these men. Another problem is to secure the villages and prove to the village people that the governments of South Vietnam and the United States can provide more and better things for the people than the Viet Cong.

At present the 199th Inf., are engaged in 165 separate civic actions within the Binh Trung Province; all these projects are outside of Saigon itself. In the town of Duc Tou, about 10 miles north of Saigon, men of the 199th Bde., are constructing a fence around the local school, while the Army donates the wood, the local carpenters will be making tables and benches for the school.

For the village of Long Thanh My, down a dirt road from the busy Bien Hoa highway, people live in grass huts and, untill recently, superstition and suchion cups were a way of healing. Now medical teams from the 30th Ranger Battalion make a weekly visit to this village and many others in the area, giving out free medical and dental work. The dentist is limited to extractions or pain killers. For this village, there are two doctors one Vietnamese the other American to treat all the sores and diseases of Vietnam.
