Mastering their weapons and men against the cities and provincials capitols of South Viet Nam, the Viet Cong unleashed a holocaust of agony and annihilation of law and order through out the searly secured populated areas; during their own Tet truce.

During the ensuing days after the 1st attack on the Philippine Embassy in Saigon, the country was put under Marshal Law, tightening security and virtually sealing off the capitol by road blocks and check points.

On Highway #1 near Bien Hoa, U.S. Military Police and an ARVN Ranger sergeant has set up one such road block, for the checking of all Viet Namese ID Cards. In these checks they hope to find VC and NVA with forged papers attempting to flee Saigon Bien Hoa area.

Between 8AM and 11 AM the road block held five people as suspects. In the 100ft shot one such suspect was held for futher questioning. A MP jeep took the suspect and the ARVN Ranger into the civilian police station in Bien Hoa where the civilian authority will handle the case.
