S U M M A R Y

Following up U.S. intelligence reports, the United States Forces launched Operation Junction City against a reported force of 10,000 men, consisting of 9th Viet Cong Division, the Headquarters of the National Liberation Front, and possibly a VC prisoner of war camp located in War Zone "C".

The 1st Inf. Div., 196th Light Inf. Brigade, 173rd Airborne Brigade, with elements of the 25th Inf Division, surrounded War Zone "C", in Tay Ninh Province about 70 miles northwest of Saigon, to act as a blocking force while the 2nd Brgt. 25th INF and the 11th Armored Cav. Regt. began a two pronged attack on 23 Feb 67.

The 25th Inf Division's 2nd Brigade (Wolfhounds) were trucked from the musting area on the 22nd of Feb, shortly after noon. These elements left for a bivouac area on the fringes of the operation zone. Along the way the convoy encountered several land mines; destroying one jeep and trailer.

The next morning "A" Company 2nd Bt, 27th Inf. 2nd Brigade 25th Inf Div. continued along the road sweeping both sides for enemy positions; which they destroyed when found. Leading the company was a SCOUT dog from the 25th Div. Able to pick up the enemy sent. The dog (German Shepherd) directed the company off the road road onto a on-cut trail used by the VC.

Continuing along this path about 2000 meters the company came upon a recently used VC bridge and bunker complex. A brief fire fight broke out with 5 to 7 Viet Cong hiding in thick brush. This area had been buried with high explosives and napalm by U.S. planes prior to the assault. Results were one U.S. wounded; and no enemy dead were found.

The next two days the company continued to sweep along jungle trails; and advance further into the Viet Cong stronghold. Saturday the 25th of Feb.; other elements of the wolfhounds made contact with the enemy; where upon they moved back allowing airstrikes on the enemy position.
