SUBJECT : SUMMIT ACTIVITIES FOR WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 26

Item No. 1 - Some Chiefs of State and Heads of Government are leaving tomorrow, October 26. The schedule of departure is the following:

9:00 a.m. - Prime Ministers of Australia and New Zealand
11:30 a.m. - President of the Republic of Korea
12:00 noon - Chief of State and Head of Government of the Republic of South Vietnam
3:55 p.m. - Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Thailand

On the same day, however, President Johnson and President Marcos will visit Los Baños and Corregidor. Media representatives wishing to go to Los Baños will not be able to join the party to Corregidor as there are not enough transportation facilities by air.

Item No. 2 - Press cabs will be available to bring newsmen to Manila International Airport for the departure ceremonies.

Item No. 3 - All media men desiring to go to Los Baños must be at the Manila Hotel lobby at 7:30 a.m. where they will board vehicles for Los Baños. Departure time is exactly 8:00 a.m. Media men who will not be at Manila Hotel on the time specified will be left behind. Points of interests to be visited will be the U.P. School of Agriculture and the IRRI compound where scientific rice culture is being undertaken.

Item No. 4 - Those desiring to go to Corregidor will follow the following schedule:

a. Newsmen desiring to cover Corregidor activities will be picked up by press cabs from their respective hotels to be at the embarkation point -- Philippine Navy Headquarters, Roxas Boulevard -- not later than 9:30 a.m. October 26.

b. Newsmen will be ferried aboard RPS Pagasa with passenger capacity of 250 and RPS Cavite with passenger capacity of 50. In addition, the back-up ship, RPS Bohol, can accommodate 30 passengers.

c. It will be a 3-hour trip from Manila to Corregidor and a similar travel time on the return trip. Departure from Corregidor will be 4:30 p.m. same day.

d. Upon arrival at Corregidor, the newsmen, radio-TV correspondents will be ferried aboard 6 x 6 army trucks to the site of ceremonies. These trucks will serve as platforms for photographers and movie-TV cameramen.

e. At 4:00 a.m. or earlier on the same day, October 26, RPS Bulacan (LST) will load movie-TV mobile units to be positioned before the arrival of VIPs. Sub-TF Kapayapaan (marine and naval elements and AFP
