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RECENT PROCLAMATIONS

Of recent GVN decrees and proclamations, the following will be of general interest:

- 1) Armed Forces Council, duties and organization - AFC Statute; and,
- 2) Office of Deputy Prime Minister for Planning, transfer thereto of certain agencies - Decree No. 45-TTP.

DUTIES AND ORGANIZATION OF ARMED FORCES COUNCIL

ARTICLE I

Objectives

Within the military sphere:

achieve justice based on qualifications and level of sacrifice,
prevent actions harmful to the morale of soldiers.
prevent abuse of the military's authority to increase personal
prestige or satisfy personal ambitions,
create conditions to unite hearts and strength of all military, and
concentrate all efforts to serve the motherland and to step up
victory over the Communists.

Within the Government sphere:

positively support an anti-Communist "clean" and progressive government in order to stabilize the situation and preserve the national security, advise the government on necessary measures to solve serious problems arising from the changing situation, and express opinions on government decisions concerning the Army and national defense.

ARTICLE II

Duties

The Republic of Vietnam Armed Forces Council shall:

represent all units of the Army, Navy and Air Force to convey all constructive opinions to the Commander-in-Chief, or when required, to decide on matters of policy and on the reorganization of the Republic of Vietnam Armed Forces; discuss and convey all constructive opinions to the government recommending necessary actions; and coordinate efforts to cope with emergencies required by the situation.

ARTICLE III

Composition

The Armed Forces Council shall be composed of:

Generals participating in the government
Commander-in-Chief of the Republic of Vietnam Armed Forces
Chief-of-Staff of Armed Forces
Chief, Political General's office
Commander of Military Training
Chief, Logistics General's office
Commanders, Tactical Zones and Corps
Commander, Capital Military Zone
Commanders of Divisions and Tactical Sectors
Commander of Air Force
Commander of Navy
Commander of Special Forces
Commander of Paratroopers
Commander of Marines
Commander of Regional Forces
Commanders of the branches of Arms: artillery, armored vehicles, engineering corps and rangers.

ARTICLE IV

Organization

The Armed Forces Council shall include:

- a steering committee of the Armed Forces Council
- a standing committee.

Members of the Armed Forces Council's Standing Committee shall include:

- Minister of Armed Forces
- Commander-in-Chief of Armed Forces
- Chief-of-Staff of Armed Forces
- Commander of Air Force
- Commanders of Tactical Zones
- Commander of Navy
- Commander of Paratroopers.

The standing committee is placed under the direction of a secretary general and shall include the following commissioners:

- Foreign Affairs Commissioners
- Political Commissioner
- Security Commissioner.

Members of the standing committee as stipulated in article IV shall be elected by secret ballot with absolute majority.

If an absolute majority is not obtained on the first ballot, a relative majority shall be used on the second ballot.

ARTICLE V

Duties - Operation

The steering committee shall determine the course of action, policies and general program of operations of the Armed Forces Council.

The standing committee shall be a permanent organization to insure continuity of performance of the duties of the Armed Forces Council. Duties of the members of this committee are as follows:

The Secretary General of the standing committee of the Armed Forces Council presides at the meetings, regulates all activities of the Armed Forces Council, coordinates activities of its members and carries out all decisions unanimously agreed upon.

The Foreign Affairs Commissioner maintains contact between the military, people and administration to solve disputes between agencies and civic groups, if required by the situation. He acts also as spokesman for the Armed Forces Council.

The Political Commissioner studies plans and courses of action of the Army concerning warfare, politics and national security.

The Security Commissioner follows up on civil situation and security in the Army ranks, enforce discipline and conduct investigations in cases of violation of policy of the Armed Forces Council.

Personnel of the Committees.

Personnel of the Secretary General and committees are selected by the Secretary General and the concerned committees. Size shall vary according to requirements of the Secretary General's Office and each committee.

Headquarters.

Headquarters of the standing committee shall be decided by the general assembly in its first meeting after promulgation of this statute.

Operations.

The General Assembly shall meet once every other month to review and vote on decisions submitted by the steering committee.

The steering committee shall meet twice every month to determine policy, general course of action and common program of operations for the Armed Forces Council.

In cases of emergency, the standing committee of the Armed Forces Council may convene extraordinary sessions.

Places of regular and extraordinary meetings are decided by the Armed Forces Council.

Discussions during a session of the general assembly must receive a two-thirds majority of the total membership for approval. If approval is not obtained on the first ballot, then two-thirds of the members present is required.

The steering committee of the Armed Forces Council shall vote on emergency matters when the general assembly cannot be convened. However, such decisions must be later ratified by the general assembly.

ARTICLE VI.

Discipline

If a member does not comply with the policy of the Armed Forces Council or performs some actions harmful to the Army, the steering committee according to the degree of gravity of the fault may either issue a warning, reprimand or expel the member from the Armed Forces Council.

All decisions of the steering committee shall be temporarily effective and must be later approved by the Council.

When a member is expelled, the Armed Forces Council shall propose to the Ministry of Armed Forces demobilization, if required.

If the offender is a member of the steering committee, he may not attend the meeting convened by the steering committee to judge his case in accordance with the proposal from the security commissioner.

If the offender is a member of the steering committee, the security commissioner shall convene a meeting to judge his case proposed by two-thirds of the members of the steering committee.

ARTICLE VII

This statute may be changed upon two-thirds vote by the members of the Armed Forces Council.

This statute shall be effective at date of implementation.

TRANSFER OF GVN AGENCIES

On 19 March, 1965, the Prime Minister signed Decree No. 45-TTP placing the following agencies under the jurisdiction of the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister for Planning:

Directorate General of Planning,
National Institute of Statistics,
Industrial Development Center,
Handicraft Development Center,
Importation Development Center,
National Agricultural Credit Office,
Directorate of Cooperative, and
Directorate of Farmers' Associations.

The organization of each of these agencies will be set forth in a subsequent arrete from the Deputy Prime Minister.

CREATION
OF
CIVILIAN AFFAIRS RELATION OFFICE*

In a circular to all province and district chiefs, mayors and the Saigon prefect, the Ministry of Interior has requested the setting-up of Civilian Affairs Relation Offices, pending a overhauling of local administrative organization. These Offices will be responsible for:

"guiding the people on all required administrative procedure" and receiving applications or claims. The Ministry stressed that in those localities where there exist ethnic minorities such as the Cham, Khmer or Montagnards, "an official native of the locality ... should ... contact the people."
