Republic of Vietnam Prime Ministry No. 117-SL/Th.T/PC2

THE PRIME MINISTER.

- Considering the Constitution of the Republic of Vietnam of April 1, 1967;
- Considering Decree No. 234-TT/SL of May 25, 1968 and the subsequent texts fixing the composition of the Government;
- Considering Ordinance No. 9 of July 14, 1950 establishing the General Statute of the Civil Service;
- Considering Decree No. 111-SL/Th.T/PC2 of August 14, 1968 fixing the composition of Anti-Corruption Committees at the Central Government, the Ministries, Agencies and at the Local Governments;
- Considering the needs of the Nation;

DECREES:

Art. 1 - To provide materials to the Anti-Corruption Committees established by the Decree No. 111-SL/Th.T/PC2 of August 14, 1968, all civil servants, employees of public agencies, and military in the active service and in the reserve service, from the non-commissioned officers and above, the personnel of all levels at the autonomous agencies, national enterprises and mixed enterprises, generally speaking all persons charged with a public function, or participating to the expenses of public funds must fill up a Declaration of Property.

Art. 2.6 The Declaration, the form of which is joint to the present decree, shall be certified exact by the interrested person, and shall enumerate the real estates, enterprises, commercial or industrial funds, crafts, automobiles, accounts at the Treasury, the Banks, under the name of this person, or his/her spouse name, or his/her sons and daughters, majors or minors, in Vietnam and abroad.

Art. 3 - The Declaration of Property must be filled up immediately after his/her entry into service, and refilled every year until the separation from the service.

For the execution of the present decree, all civil servants, employees and military listed in article 1, shall establish their first Declaration of Property in proper time as determined by the Anti-Corruption Committee at the Ministries, Agencies or Local Administrative Units.

In case of refusal to establish the declaration or to reestablish the declaration, or of fraudulent statements, the interested person shall be considered as guilty of serious offense detrimental to the service and shall be suspended from duty according to Article 55 of Ordinance No. 9 of July 14, 1950 establishing the General Statute of the Civil Service. If there is charges incurred in line of duty, an

investigation shall be conducted to try the interested person before a tribunal.

The Declaration shall be filed with the Anti-Corruption Committees at the Ministries, Agencies or Local Government units, via the hierarchical administrative or military system.

- Art. 4 The Anti-Corruption Committees at the Ministries, Agencies and Local Government units shall determine:
- 1. The kinds of employees to fill up the Declaration of Property form for each phase, progressively from the highest position and level down.
- 2. The time-limit for filing these declarations.

In any case, each phase must comprise at least 1/10 of the personnel of the interested Ministry, Agency or Local Government unit, and the time-limit for the first declaration must not exceed 1 month since the day of the promulgation of the present decree.

- Art. 5 At the end of the above period, the Ministries and Agencies Committees shall:
- 1. Establish the listings of the persons who have filled up and who have not filled up the Declaration of Property form.
- 2. Transmit these two listings and the Declarations received to the Central Anti-Corruption Committee, with their opinion, remarks and recommendations on each case.

Especially in the Prefecture, Cities and Provinces, the Presiding Judge or one Judge of the Tribunal of the location shall replace the (Mayor or) Province Chief to preside over the meetings of the Local Anti-Corruption Committee for giving opinion, remarks and recommendation in each case. Afterward, the Local

Anti-Corruption Committees shall transmit the above declarations to the Central Anti-Corruption Committee.

- Art. 6 The Central Anti-Corruption Committee may establish one or several Sub-Committees to examine the declaration, the cases of non declaration and to conduct controls or investigations which deem necessary.
- Art. 7 The Central Anti-Corruption Committee is entitled to request of all civil servants, employees and military the proof of their ownership, and to examine if their probation is sufficient.
- Art. 8 For the control of the Declaration and the examination of the proofs, the Central Anti-corruption Committee may consider all denunciations either they are anonymous or not, and make use of all investigation means of the Executive power, especially the tax personnel, the personnel in charge of the registration of real estates, crafts, automobiles, commercial or industrial productions.
- Art. 9 The Central Anti-Corruption Committee shall recommend to the Prime Minister:
- 1. To issue the texts suspending from duty:
 - the persons who are not willing to fill up their declaration,
 - the persons who refuse to give the proof of their ownership,
 - the persons who have given the proof of their ownership, which the Committee considers as insufficient.
- 2. To order the opening of formal investigations for trying the interested persons before the Tribunal, if there is a proof of violation of the law incurred in line of duty.
- Art. 10 Ministers of State, Ministers and Under-

secretaries, each as to that which concerns him, are charged with the execution of the present decree. The present decree shall be published in the Official Journal of Vietnam.

Republic of Vietnam Prime Ministry No. 145-SL/Th.T/PC2

THE PRIME MINISTER OF THE GOVERNMENT,

- Considering the Constitution of April 1, 1967;
- Considering Decree No. 234-TT/SL of May 25, 1968 and the subsequent texts determining the composition of the Government;
- In view of Decree No. 111-SL/Th.T/PC2 of August 14, 1968, fixing the composition of the Anti-Corruption Committee at the Centralization, Ministries Agencies and Provinces;
- In view of Decree No. 117-SL/Th.T/PC2 of August 22, 1968 determining the Declaration of Property;
- On the recommendation of the Central Anti-Gorruption Committee, in its session of September 26, 1968;
- Considering the national needs;

DECREES:

Art. 1 - Now is hereby modified Art. 2 of Decree No. 111/SL/Th.T/PC2 of Aug. 14, 1968 on the composition of the local Anti-Corruption Committee;

Art. 2 (new)

- Committees at the Prefecture, Cities and Provinces
- Chairman, Council of the Prefecture, City or Province...... Chairman

Representative of the Prefect, Mayor or Province Chief.....

Member

Two representatives of the Notabilities (on the invitation of the Council of Prefecture, City or Province).....

Members

Three representatives of the Military, the Cadres and the Civil Servants elected by each branch......

Members

No change for the remaining part.

Art. 2 - Now is hereby modified Art. 5 of Decree No. 117-SL/Th.T/PC2 of August 22, 1968 on the Return of Property as follows:

"Art. 5 (new) - At the expiration of the above time-limit, the Committees at the Ministries, Agencies and local government shall:

- 1. Establish the listings of the persons who have filed the declaration and of those who have not filed the Declaration of property form;
- 2. Transmit these two listings and the Declarations received to the Central Anti-Corruption Committee with their opinion, remarks and recommendations on each case.
- Art. 3 Ministers of State, Ministers and Under Secretaries are charged, as far as each is concerned, of the execution of the present decree.

The present decree shall be published in the Official Journal of the Republic of Vietnam.
